The endorsement of the National Association of Independent Fee Appraisers has value. The harshest critics in any profession come from their own peers. The NAIFA has set a higher level of standards for their membership. Each appraiser is awarded a specific designation after being reviewed by their fellow peers in the appraisal profession. The process requires the candidate to submit sample appraisal reports for review. The samples are then evaluated. The reviewers are looking for clarity, credibility, accuracy, precision, relevance, depth, logic, experience and ethics. A NAIFA endorsement requires the appraiser to go beyond the standards set by the Federal and State Governments that license appraisers. It requires the appraiser to adhere to a higher level of standards on a daily basis. When an appraiser earns the endorsement of the NAIFA, it becomes a testimonial of the value of each report put out by that appraiser. Each NAIFA designated appraiser must comply with a strict code of ethics set forth by National. A NAIFA designation is both a privilege and a responsibility. Each designation has different requirements for that specific discipline. A National Association of Independent Fee Appraiser designation brings value to the appraiser, the profession and their services because of integrity. Integrity, that's who we are.
